MOTIONS DEBATED AND VOTED UPON 8:30-12:00

Servas International Statutes: The proposed statutes dated June 2012 were approved as presented, except the number of hosts required for a member country was not changed. The necessary changes that came from previous approved motions were included in the approved statutes as well. **EXC-023:** The President, Treasurer and General Secretary are empowered to sign for financial matters. **ACCEPTED.** **EXC-024:** It was decided that the next GA will be held at 2015. New Zealand and Colombia offered to be the hosting country. EXCO will decide the hosting country amongst them and other countries that wish to volunteer. **TUR-006:** That Servas National groups should be encouraged to report regularly on peace activities in their country to the SI Peace Secretary who will then distribute this information to all national groups. **ACCEPTED.** **BRI-003:** That opportunities for travelers regarding projects with volunteering or educational activities will be shared on Servas Websites. **ACCEPTED.** **USA-001:** All money collected in the name of Servas must be used for Servas purposes only. **ACCEPTED.**

SERVAS IDENTIFICATION CARD

In this SERVAS youth meeting 2012, there has been a proposal to create a **SERVAS identification card for the members.**

No more handwriting. The change of this information into a digital format and in real time, would involve fewer errors. **There would be no need for photographs.** They would be already printed. It would be in a different format rather than the letter of introduction, more practical to use than paper. The problem with bureaucracy **to have the stamp** for the letter of introduction (LOI) could be solved by using a card and a digital signature that should be given to an authorized SERVAS person.
